This letter is being sent to people, all of whom own a part of the same mountain. Yet, very few of these people could identify their neighbors on sight. In your home neighborhood you are aware of your neighbors and their habits. This awareness or recognition provides you and your neighbors with a certain amount of comfort simply by this recognition. This contest will judge three culinary dishes: a Dreamy Dip, a Super Salad, and a Dapper Dessert. Ballots will be provided for those wandering MUNCHERS to vote for their favorites. Please do not go overboard; there is no intention that you should provide for anyone but your immediate family.

I'm well aware that the community is made up of families and that families mean there will be children running around investigating all the rocks and rills. Since the mountain consists mainly of trees, rocks and shale, the normal youth games, races, etc., would create skinned knees and cut lips.
